Related Guidelines and Additional Measures

Everyone is familiar with the current pandemic issues and RBI Sport as rally organizer will have to apply specific measures to minimize the risk of the Covid-19 spread as well.

Please read and prepare for the following specific Covid-19 related guidelines and additional measures.

1) Online Verification of Documents for the Administrative Check

Large groups of people at one place and overcrowding have to be avoided at the rally and physical distancing is required. In order to speed up the process and make it as save as possible, we ask first of all to do the following:

- Competitors and mechanics to be registered **in the online data tool until 24.08.2020**. Access through the rally official website www.rallye-breslau.com by clicking on the blue button "register".
- It is required to upload all necessary and VALID documents for the online document verification until **24.08.2020**. How to do it:

Step1: Login to the team account.

Step 2: Select the rally crew to which you want to add documents.

Step 3: Open the appropriate section: Driver, Co-Driver(s), Service crew or "Service vehicle".

Step 4: Click the upload/change buttons under relevant document.

Step 5: Select the document from your computer. JPG images and PDF documents are allowed for upload. Multiple pages must be merged in to one single PDF file.

Step 6: Update / Save the application form as for the document to be stored in the cloud system.

- Please make yourself familiar with the Waiver of Liability. You will sign it personally at the Administrative Check at the rally.
- Please note: The originals of the documents to be brought by you to the rally.

2) Administrative Check at the rally

- -The Administrative Check procedure will be given additional day and more time. It will start on 12.09.2020 in the afternoon, time to be announced in Camp 1, Gwda Wielka, Poland.
- On 12.09, 13.09 and 14.09 will be possible to proceed through the Administrative Check.

Please use the additional time slots on the 12.09 in order to avoid large groups of people on 14.09.2020.

- Please wear a face mask during the procedure.

Additional hygiene measures:

- In the tent for Administrative Check will be arranged a disinfection station with hand sanitizer.
- Transparent protective walls will be used between the ORGA members and the participants
- Please bring your own pen
- Physical distancing: Signs/Marking for the waiting participants will be arranged. Please follow the restrictions and keep 1.5m distance.

3) Camp Control

- In Camp 1 will be carried out a procedure to check the participants who enter the first camp and if they are registered or not. It is highly important to have all rally crew members registered in the online tool prior to arrival at the rally. This will reduce waiting time and unnecessary money exchange in terms of deposit payment for the not registered members. Even if a certain member, in most cases a service member has to be added to the rally crew or replaced with another, please send a short email with his/her details to info@rallye-breslau.com in advance. This will ensure that a specific number will be assigned to the person and the process at the Camp Control and the Administrative Check will be significantly speeded up.
- Disinfectants/hand sanitizers will be placed.
- ORGA members will wear face masks/face shields.
- Body temperature of the participants will be measured electronically on the forehead.

4) Technical Scrutineering

- Additional day and more time for the Technical Scrutineering: will start on 12.09.2020 in the afternoon, time to be announced, in Camp 1, Gwda Wielka, Poland.
- On 12.09, 13.09 and 14.09 will be possible to proceed through the Scrutineering

Please use the additional time slots on the 12.09 in order to avoid large groups of people on 14.09.2020.

- Please wear face mask/protection during the procedure.
- ORGA members will wear face masks/face shields.
- Disinfectants/hand sanitizers will be placed.
- Please keep physical distance of 1.5m between each other.

5) First Aid Course

No first aid course at the rally. Presentation materials will be sent out.

6) Fan Shop

- Signs reminding of the physical distance requirements will be placed at sight. Please follow them.
- 2 persons at once will be allowed to the Fan Shop.
- ORGA members will wear with face masks/face shields.
- Disinfectants/hand sanitizers will be available.
- Highly recommended also the participants to wear face masks.

7) Camp/Parc Ferme/ Service Park

- Please keep physical distance and follow the additional hygiene measures: proper hand washing, using of hand sanitizer, wearing of face mask/protection where needed.

8) Drivers' Briefing

- Large groups of people at one place have to be avoided. Limitation: just driver and co-driver to be present.
- Wearing of face mask/protection during the Drivers' briefing is mandatory.
- Please keep physical distance of 1.5m.
- When possible, written briefing notes will be sent out via e-mail.

9) Official Notice Board and Classifications

- There will be no physical Official Notice Board at the rally to avoid gathering of people at close distance.

- Digital Notice Board will be available online. The exact URL address will be communicated. All results, classifications, communication, bulletins and other important documents will be published there.

10) Race Office

- It is very important to reduce people crowding in the Race Office. A door bell will be installed outside. Please ring the bell and an Official will come out.
- Transparent protection wall will be installed.
- -Please wear face mask/protection.
- Protests, questions etc. to be given in written form.

11) Rally Control

- ORGA members will work at required distance from each other. Big groups of people are not allowed in the Rally Control. If it is highly necessary to talk to the Rally Control, make an appointment through Race Office, wear face mask/protection and keep physical distance.

12) Catering

- Overcrowding at close distance must be strictly avoided. Signs/Marking for participants waiting for the food will be placed. Please keep physical distance.
- At one (1) table with two (2) benches will be allowed max. 6 people. Signs will be put on the benches.
- The food: breakfast, lunch package and dinner will be put in separate menu containers with lids (assiette) and handed out to the participants.
- Transparent protection walls at the kitchen truck will be installed.
- Catering personnel will wear face protection and disposable hand gloves.
- Disinfectants/hand sanitizers will be available.

13) WC, Showers

- More toilets and sinks with hand washing soap and hand sanitizer will be placed.
- Disinfectants/hand sanitizers will be available in the shower truck as well.
- Please keep physical distance of 1.5m.







14) Award Ceremony

This year a special finish procedure and award giving directly after the finish of the last rally leg will take place. Special awards for the finishers and photo corner will be organized at the finish. RBI Sport is not allowed to organize the typical big Breslau party in the Camp because of the Covid-19 restrictions and the guidelines to avoid any form of people overcrowding at one place.
