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Welcome to Rallye Breslau Poland 2021

Dear Participants,

It is our pleasure and honor to welcome you to Rallye Breslau Poland 2021.

We are extremely glad and very proud to share that the oldest offroad rally in Europe is simultaneously the biggest international offroad event this year. With more than 25 years of history Rallye Breslau will accommodate an unprecedented number of competitors.



Entries:

403 rally teams from 25 nationalities are now on the entry list of Rallye Breslau.

The number of the entrants speaks for itself. At the start line on 28th of June we expect:

56 motorbikes, 51 quads, 92 side-by-sides, 91 cross country cars, 33 extreme cars, 32 cross country trucks, 18 extreme trucks and 30 vehicles in the non-racing category.

You can get ready for an amazing one-time competition!

New bivouac for the mega edition of the Breslau

Following the huge competitor field, we organized a new - much bigger bivouac. There we will feel more comfortable and can accommodate everyone. At the same time, we follow a sanitary protocol and want to ensure that more space will be provided for adequate physical distance. More information in the Camps – section in this rally guide.

The first camp will be open on Friday, 25th of June and the Administrative Check this year will start also on Friday. The Administrative Check will start earlier - one more day will be given for this procedure due to the large number of participants. Time slots for the Technical Scrutineering will also be defined. We do our best to manage everything in the cleverest way and facilitate all activities during the rally for this large number of participants.

This year the rally days will be from Monday, 28th of June to Friday, 2nd of July. Just like in 2020, the different rally classes will start at different places, after which they will rotate. That's the safest way to organize it. Mid-day service breaks will be arranged. The rally itinerary will present a challenging scenario and a lot of rally fun, for sure. A night stage is on the agenda and more challenging sections for the teams in the Extreme category.











Rally director Alexander Kovatchev for the upcoming edition:

"Rallye Breslau has never been bigger than this year and it seems that we are even bigger than the Dakar of 2021. We expect more than 400 competitor teams. This is a huge challenge, but we have a very good concept that we have been continuously improving. In the last ten years, we have changed a lot in terms of organization. We race Monday to Friday, so participants only need five working days. Everyone can go back to work on Monday after the rally. The separation of the cars and motorcycles, the accurate timekeeping and satellite tracking (both developed entirely inhouse), the ability to communicate when overtake or in danger, together with the top trained ORGA, make Rallye Breslau a world leader and trend setter in sporting and safety perspectives. Our communication and marketing are well structured, competent and honest, because we "speak the language" of the competitors. We are a multinational family where people respect and care for each other, and where the good old spirit of motorsport has never left. Finally, yet importantly, our entry fees are very favorable. Being regularly asked by other organizers how we could achieve this, I answer that we are the "Lidl "of rallies. There you will find everything you need, of good quality and very affordable.

This situation around the Corona virus differs per country, but it looks good in Poland. We work closely with the government, as we did during the Fenix Rally in Tunisia. The future will tell us, which events will continue to do well and which will not. RBI Sport has also had its difficulties, but we have been growing every year and will be continuing to exist. The pandemic is a worldwide problem and a test for all mankind, being a difficulty to one but a possibility for another."

We look forward to this one-time incredible edition of Rallye Breslau.


























Safety Instructions

HIGHLY IMPORTANT:

Offroad rallies in Poland are generally taking place on military polygons. These are strictly controlled military zones with special rules for usage and behaviour.

The military polygons CSWL Drawsko Pomorskie and Biedrusko are hospitable and highly respected partners with relations to Rallye Breslau lasting since more than 20 years. Rallye Breslau fully complies with the house order and the requirements of the military polygon and will **NOT tolerate** any infringement against the established rules.

WARNING:

- 1. Racing vehicles are NOT allowed to drive on the polygon except during the rally legs.
- 2. Press vehicles are NOT allowed to drive on the polygon except being a part of the official press convoy of the rally.
- 3. Service vehicles are NOT allowed to drive on the polygon except using the assigned routes to the spectators' points given by the Organiser and ONLY till the Special Stage is still open.
- 4. Fans and other members of the racing teams are fully obliged to follow the orders of the Organiser.

ANY INFRINGEMENT WILL BE PURSUED AND PENALISED!

Each person entering the polygon must have an identity document.

For safety reasons it is forbidden to move away from the designated spectators' points. For safety reasons it is forbidden to collect and lift objects that are on the ground.

While at spectators' points fans must pay special attention to any objects on the ground, as they may pose a danger.

For Cross Country and Extreme - Minimum 7 vehicles should be registered in one class in order to make a separate ranking.











Technical scrutineering

The fact to present a vehicle at the technical check is considered as an implicit declaration of conformity.

At the scrutineering will be controlled the obligatory technical condition and the mandatory equipment.

The vehicle must be presented at the scrutineering in the same way as it would go to the prestart. Read below for more details.

The vehicle must be comply with the technical requirements in the Regulations at all times.

The participant receives the start permission after successfully passing administrative check and technical scrutineering and administrative check.

- Scrutineering starts on Saturday, 26th of June and ends on Sunday, 27th of June. If you passed the Administrative Check on Friday, 25th of June, you can go for the Technical Scrutineering on the next day, Saturday.
- At the Administrative Check will be given TIME SLOTS for the Technical Scrutineering. They will be given on the "first comes, first served" principle at the Administrative Check.
- 4 separate lines will be arranged at the Technical Scrutineering: Enduro, ATV/QUAD; Side-by-Side/SSV; CAR and TRUCK.
- Make sure to come on time for your slot.
- All the required equipment as per the technical regulations (for example: helmets, fire extinguishers, seat belt cutters, gloves, tow straps, etc.) have to be prepared in advance before entering the Scrutineering zone – on the co-driver's seat when applicable.
- In order to follow the COVID PROTOCOL and large groups of people to be avoided at the Scrutineering —only 1 person shall come with the vehicle.
- Please note the rally vehicle has to be compliant with the requirements in the Technical Regulations during the whole rally. Regular checks during the rally can be done at any time.
- Vehicles from the Discovery category shall not come to the Technical
 Scrutineering. They need to do self-check according the checklist. Equipment and
 GPS tracker will be checked at the first start.
- For better preparation and to save time during the Scrutineering read/download the Scrutineering check list for your racing class, prepare the mandatory equipment and the vehicle:

Rally Safety System/Com-Box
















Each rally vehicle will be fitted with a tracking device: "Rally Safety System".

By means of sensors the device communicates with satellites, locates the vehicle and makes each second a record of the exact position, the time, the speed and the driving direction plus many other parameters.

Everybody who has access to internet – no matter through PC, tablet or cell phone can follow the rally LIVE. An extra button will appear on the website www.rallye-breslau.com before the rally starts.

Through our unique feature called Rally Replay the event can be reviewed from many perspectives by competitors, fans, sponsors, authorities. Direct comparison between drivers can be done by just a mouse click. The entertainment and analysis last much longer.

IMPORTANT: Geotraq Rally Safety System has been upgraded in 2020. The participants will drive with the latest feature – the Com-Box, allowing vehicle-to-vehicle communication. Modern technology enables the participants to request overtaking with a single push of a button. The subject of safety plays a key role and we are doing our best to incorporate meaningful improvements in the safety system.

Rally Safety System – requirements and mounting

It is the responsibility of the competitors alone to provide enough space for the Com-Box.

It is mandatory that each rally vehicle has properly installed and working "RALLY SAFETY SYSTEM" on board.

Rental of Rally Safety System

Rental fees for the Safety Tracking System (incl. vehicle-to vehicle communication) are included in the entry fees.

Deposit for safety tracking systems – **300** € - Deposits are refunded when the equipment is brought back in working condition at the end of the rally. Any damage to the equipment must be paid according to the supplier's part list.

Rally Safety System components

- 1.1. GPS Tracker 75 x 75 x 30 mm. The device is IP 67 protected and have built in battery providing back up power if the external power is lost. See bellow possible installation locations and positions
- 1.2. Com-Box 75 x 75 x 30 mm. The device is IP 67 protected and have built in battery providing back up power if the external power is lost. See bellow possible installation locations and positions.
- 1.3. Buzzer/Alarm 55 x 55 x 70 mm
- 1.4. Base/Mount bracket for Com-box 75 x 75 x 25 mm. See bellow possible installation locations and positions.
- 1.5. RF extension and antenna installed on the buzzer/alarm or Com-box
















Power supply

- 1.6. IMPORTANT!!! The battery master cut-off (kill) switch MUST NOT DISCONNECT the power supply for the Rally Safety System.
- 1.7. It is the responsibility of the competitors alone to provide, DIRECT POWER SUPPLY from the vehicle's battery according to the drawings provided.
- 1.8. The power cables must be "flexible" (multi wire), insulated cables 2 x min 0.5 to 1.25 mm2 (preferably with RED and BLACK insulation color).
- 1.9. The connection may have an IN-LINE FUSE "BLADE TYPE" of 5A.

VEHICLE's BATTERY



- 1.10. The wires must be prepared in advance and connected to the vehicle's battery when the vehicle is presented for scrutineering.
- 1.11. The cable must have minimum 50cm extra usable length from the middle of the dash board (See installation position).
- 1.12. The connection to the Rally Safety System will be done with a simple connector terminals supplied by the organizer.

Connectors

- 1.13. The power supply cables (Power+ and Ground-) must be equipped with FULLY INSULATED FEMALE Crimp Spade Terminal Connector 6.3 x 0.8mm.
- 1.14. See the graphic bellow for example:
















Com-Box Installation

- 1.15. Base/Mount bracket will be distributed at the administrative check to each crew and must be installed on the rally vehicle before scrutineering.
- 1.16. Base/Mount bracket can be directly bolted or zip-tied or stuck to the rally vehicle at the designated location by the crew. It is the responsibility of the crew alone to install the bracket before scrutineering.
- 1.17. A minimum of 75mm on the sliding side of the bracket and 25mm on the antenna side must be free for the Com-Box unit.
- 1.18. The installation location must be in reach of the Rider or Co-driver for operation in the rally.





1.19. No bolt/screw heads or cable/zip ties can protrude over the red line as marked bellow.






















Administrative check - IMPORTANT

Every single person in the Camp (driver, co-driver, mechanic or assistance person, guest, press, ORGA member etc.) will have to come to the Administrative Check and sign the documents personally.

With the unprecedented high number of competitors, this year the organization will issue queue time slots for both Administrative Check and Technical Scrutineering. The RBI Sport team is working to optimize the process and the waiting times. Prepare copies of the required documents for the Administrative Check and the required equipment for the Technical Scrutineering. These new time slots are to organize the waiting at the queue. Please be patient and cooperative.

1. Registration Desk / Reception

- As soon as your team arrived in the camp and is ready for the document check, you can proceed towards the Registration Desk, where your team will be given the first empty queue number / free slot. The numbers are based on "first comes, first served principle".
- The Administrative check will be done according to these numbers. Before entering the Administrative check queue, there will be control that will only allow in the teams with the active slots.
- Person in charge will regularly deliver information in the WhatsApp groups about the proceeding of the queue and which slot is currently active.
- If you received a higher number /slot, you do not need to wait at the queue. Arrange something else, have a chat or take photos and after a while, you can get back to the queue. RBI Sport team aims to organize the process also as pleasant as possible.
- It's recommended to come together as a team. This will facilitate the process, because each person from the team has to sign documents and will receive identification.
- If you miss your slot, or you have a late coming team member, you/the team member will need to get back in line and get another slot.













2. Administrative Check

- It will start on Friday, 25th of June at 15:00 CET in Camp 1. If possible, come on Friday as you will pass then earlier through all necessary the procedures.
- Reminder: there is Camp control and everyone who is not registered in the database will have to pay 300 euro per person deposit in cash, which will be credit after passing the full registration process at the Administrative Check.
- You already received the dossiers sent per e-mail. All documents marked as
 missing/not valid need to be presented at the Administrative Check. Please bring
 copies of the valid and correct documents and be ready to present the originals.
 IMPORTANT: especially for the RALLY VEHICLES you have to bring copies of the
 GREEN INSURANCE CARD, not the local insurance.
- The last day for Administrative Check is Sunday, 27th of June.

WHO IS CONSIDERED AS AN "ASSISTANCE PERSON OR A SERVICE PERSON"?

The assistance/service person at Rallye Breslau is every person, which accompanies the rally team - mechanic, wife, husband, friend, fan of the racing team etc. These persons receive the full package of services at the rally and access to all rally facilities.

IMPORTANT: Rest payments of the fees can be done at the Administrative Check only in cash.

Camps

IMPORTANT: Camp 1 is located on the South side of Drawsko Polygon, between the city of Recz and Kalisz Pomorski. Due to the fact that the camp is placed on an active military ground, the entry and exit has been clearly negotiated with the authorities and will be from the main road No10. The Entry to the camp will be clearly marked with signs and arrows in order to navigate you to the center if it.



Camp access

The access into the camp is with: COMPETITTION CARD It was sent out via e-mail to all registered participants.

Persons who don't have an entry number will have to pay a 300 € p. person deposit which will be credited in full on the registration at the Administrative Check.

Each car will receive a sticker after passing the entry check/camp control. Similar to sticker allows access to the first camp.

After the Administrative Check each team will receive a set of stickers for the vehicles, which must be placed according to the sticker plan.

The access into the next camps is with ID card for the participants and start numbers for the vehicles.

ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE OBLIGATED TO FOLLOW THE RULES IN THE CAMPS.

Electricity

At the camps no electricity is available – self-sufficiency is required.











Warnings



Beware of ticks, mosquitoes and snakes! Bring and use proper repellents during the rally. Inspect yourself and your clothes closely for ticks.

Wildlife on the rally route



What should drivers do if they encounter wildlife on the road?

Slow down - collision avoidance and driver response time are improved at slower speeds. Anticipate unpredictable behaviour from all wildlife. Some animals travel together so where there is one animal, there may be more. Watch for mother/offspring pairs.

What should drivers do if a crash is inevitable?

Sometimes, there is no real choice except to strike the animal. If this is the case, look where you want to go, not at the animal. The vehicle tends to go where you look. Brake firmly and quickly, then look, and steer your vehicle to strike the animal at an angle. Let up on the brake just before you hit the animal. This causes the front end of your vehicle to rise and reduces the chances of the animal coming through your windshield.

What should drivers do if an animal is hit, or if there is a dead animal beside the road?

This depends on road and traffic conditions, and the condition of the driver. Pull off the road. Turn on hazard lights. Stay away from wounded animals, as they can be very dangerous. You are not required to put an injured animal out of its misery or move a dead animal. Inspect your vehicle to see if it safe to continue driving. Call the Rally control immediately and follow their instructions. Reporting the exact location of collisions helps wardens monitor injured animals and recover dead ones. Quick removal prevents other animals from being attracted to the highway.

What do drivers need to know about wildlife behaviour in order to anticipate hazards?













Animal behaviour is related to the "fight-or-flight response". There is a certain amount of space in which an animal feels safe; but once that boundary is violated, the animal's reaction is unpredictable. Even if an animal sees you, it may still jump in front of your vehicle. Some animals travel together, for example deer, bighorn sheep, and mother/offspring pairs. If one animal crosses the road, others may follow. If an animal has crossed the road, it may turn and cross again. Animals standing calmly at the side of the road may bolt unexpectedly.

Catering

The Entry includes catering services: Catering starts with a breakfast on Monday morning 28.06.2021 and ends with dinner on Saturday evening 02.07.2021 in the Camp.

The daily menu consists of a breakfast, take away lunch package (given at breakfast) and dinner.

The catering doesn't include drinks, except coffee and tea at breakfast.

IMPORTANT: This year due to the additional hygienic measures the food will be packaged and served in take-away boxes. Please follow the Sanitary protocol. Wear face mask, keep distance, wash and disinfect your hands more often.

Car wash and fuel stations

Washing cars in the Camps is prohibited. Local car wash is available near Camps. Local fuel stations are available near the Camps.

Waste

In the central areas of the Camps there are garbage containers. Please leave the places clean!

All waste materials, packaging materials, exchanged vehicle parts; old tires, empty paint cans and oil, batteries, etc. must be taken and disposed by the participants themselves.

Oil/Liquids

At any time of the rally the service teams are responsible to have oil binders and containers for disposal of oil/brake fluid, etc. Used oil must be collected.













General environmental regulations

The Organiser has been committed by the site owner to make every effort to protect the environment perfectly. The teams are asked to place a large plastic trap underneath their rally vehicle for the duration of the service work. The plans must be sufficiently thick, it may not be damaged and it needs to be media-resistant, i.e. resistant to oil, fuel, coolant and brake fluid, and battery acid.

Also, wild animals are living in the Polish forests. Be careful and protect them.

Refuelling

Refuelling is authorized at fuel commercial stations servicing the towns crossed by the rally route or along the national route and it must be paid in euro or local currency.

The petrol stations where competitors may refuel are indicated in the road book.

Carrying fuel in the rally vehicle is strictly forbidden.

FUEL AUTONOMY:

- Enduro 130 km
- ATV 90 km.
- SSV, Cars & Trucks around 180 km

Each competitor is responsible of the calculation of his autonomy. He cannot in any case make up against the Organization if his vehicle doesn't reach the coverage of the minimum distance 130km (Enduro), 90km (ATV), 180km (SSV, Cars & Trucks), whichever is the nature of the terrain. For safety reasons, an additional autonomy of 10% is recommended.

IMPORTANT: The ENDURO and ATV riders must bring jerry cans, which will be transported by the organization to the remote refuelling zones.











WARNING: ONLY standard METAL JERRYCANS (known as military jerry cans) will be accepted for transportation to the remote refuel zones. All other containers will be left. Same means for parts, tools, etc. Competitors cannot make any protest against the Organization in this case.



IMPORTANT: Following the latest itinerary:

- ENDURO riders must have ready 1 metal jerry can (1 remote refuelling zone in a Leg)
- ATV riders must have ready 2 metal jerry cans (2 separate remote refuelling zones in a Leg)
 Detailed information regarding the locations of the remote refuelling
 zones for ENDURO and ATV will be provided at the Driver's briefing, the road
 book and Communications on the Digital Notice Board.

IMPORTANT: The organization will provide numbered stickers/labels that must be placed on both narrow sides of the metal jerry cans for identification according to the graphic.

For safety reasons, when refuelling at camps, crews must ensure to be placed far from inflammable material such as dry grass or dry tree branches, and to be at safety distance from other vehicles. The refuelling responsibility concerns also the crew, engines must be off and the people must remain outside the vehicle during refuelling.

Advertising and identification. Sticker plan.

Access to the rally (start and finish of the Legs, service points, camps, etc.) is exclusively reserved to all those wearing the identifying card of RBI Sport (competitors, service, organisation members, media and to all vehicles officially registered (competitors, service, press, ORGA) supplied with the official stickers of the event.













ADVERTISING AND STICKER PLAN

The stickers' space reserved for the Organisers official advertising and start numbers are described in the official Sticker Plan that is under no exception mandatory for all the participants in the rally (crews, service and press):

The stickers will be distributed to competitors at the dedicated place and shall be affixed according to the defined in the sticker plan layout by the participants.

Participants are obliged to attach the start numbers and the stickers with the advertisements of the rally sponsors on their vehicles according to the given plan. The stickers must be visible for the duration of the rally.

This means that at least the areas of the vehicles with the official event stickers have to be cleaned every day, so that the stickers remain visible.

Noncompliance to the sticker plan will result in a scrutineering refusal. Any deliberate removal of the organisers/sponsors sticker will result in a possible disqualification or/and cash penalty equivalent to 20% of the entry fee (per person). The scrutineer or any rally official present has the final word in this matter.

At any time during the rally, the absence or faulty positioning of the stickers may incur, on certification, a cash penalty equivalent to 10% of the entry fees (per person). The absence or faulty positioning of the stickers same time may result in a cash penalty equivalent to 20% of the entry fee (per person).

Competitors are allowed to affix any kind of advertising to their vehicles, provided that:

- it is not likely to give offense;
- it does not encroach upon the spaces defined in the sticker plan;
- it does not interfere with the crew's vision through the windows;
- it does not express either a religious and/or political opinion.

No political, religious or abusive advertising is permitted. The advertising of tobacco (or related products), alcohol and/or pornography is forbidden on cars, competition/service equipment and on the team members' outfits.











Identification

Each participant at the events of RBI Sport (competitors, service, organisation members, media) will get an identifying card (ID card), included in the entry fee.

The ID card worn around the neck, mechanics and assistance personnel, are considered the only authorization to access the rally official location, service areas, press points and the camps.

The ID card will be systematically checked by the Organisation at meals, at service points or service areas, at the camps, etc. Participants must show the ID card at any moment upon request.

Any infringement found by an Organisation official, will imply a penalty of 300,- EUR. In case of damage of the ID card, the participant must refer to the Rally Administration.

- Meep the nature clean!



Amendments to the Sporting Regulations

52. Refuelling in Selective sections (Remote Refuelling zones)

52.1 General

- **52.1.4.** In cases where the official remote refuelling zone is in a Selective Section, the stopping time will not be will be deducted from the total Selective Section time of the competitor.
- **52.1.5.** Any crew which does not follow these refuelling regulations will receive a 15-minute time penalty in addition to the 15 minutes 10 minutes of neutralization time

52.2 Procedure

- **52.2.1.** The following procedures will apply in the official remote refuelling zones in Selective Sections:
 - the crew must be outside the vehicle during refueling;
 - while at the refueling point, only actions directly involved in the refueling of the competing vehicle are permitted;
 - after refueling, the vehicle must immediately be removed from the refueling point;
 - after refueling, no intervention on the vehicle is allowed, apart from that carried out by the crew itself with the on-board equipment; Parc fermé rules apply.
 - no team personnel are allowed in the RZ;
 - the crew alone will be responsible for the refueling operation;
 - the Organizer will provide the fuel, the pump and an adequate fire-fighting service;
 - the Organizer will provide the environmental mats;
 - The neutralization time will be 15 minutes 10 minutes.
- **52.2.2.** The start of the following part of the Selective Section will be at a target start time, determined by adding to the arrival time for the previous part of the Selective Section the **10 minutes** for the Neutralisation Zone, i.e. the arrival time of the first part of the Selective Section + **10 minutes** = target start time of the next part of the Selective Section



With the unprecedented high number of competitors, this year the organization will issue queue time slots for both Administrative Check and Technical Scrutineering. The RBI Sport team is working to optimize the process and the waiting times. Prepare copies of the required documents for the Administrative Check and the required equipment for the Technical Scrutineering. These new time slots are to organize the waiting at the queue. Please be patient and cooperative.

1. Registration Desk / Reception

- As soon as your team arrived in the camp and is ready for the document check, you can proceed towards the Registration Desk, where your team will be given the first empty queue number / free slot. The numbers are based on "first comes, first served principle".
- The Administrative check will be done according to these numbers. Before entering the
 Administrative check queue, there will be control that will only allow in the teams with the active
 slots.
- Person in charge will regularly deliver information in the WhatsApp groups about the proceeding of the queue and which slot is currently active.
- If you received a higher number /slot, you do not need to wait at the queue. Arrange something else, have a chat or take photos and after a while, you can get back to the queue. RBI Sport team aims to organize the process also as pleasant as possible.
- It's recommended to come together as a team. This will facilitate the process, because each person from the team has to sign documents and will receive identification.
- If you miss your slot, or you have a late coming team member, you/the team member will need to get back in line and get another slot.

2. Administrative Check

- It will start on Friday, 25th of June at 15:00 CET in Camp 1. If possible, come on Friday as you will pass then earlier through all necessary the procedures.
- Reminder: there is Camp control and everyone who is not registered in the database will have to
 pay 300 euro per person deposit in cash, which will be credit after passing the full registration
 process at the Administrative Check.
- You already received the dossiers sent per e-mail. All documents marked as missing/not valid need
 to be presented at the Administrative Check. Please bring copies of the valid and correct documents
 and be ready to present the originals. IMPORTANT: especially for the RALLY VEHICLES you have
 to bring copies of the GREEN INSURANCE CARD, not the local insurance.
- The last day for Administrative Check is Sunday, 27th of June.



3. Technical Scrutineering

- Scrutineering starts on Saturday, 26th of June and ends on Sunday, 27th of June. If you passed the Administrative Check on Friday, 25th of June, you can go for the Technical Scrutineering on the next day, Saturday.
- At the Administrative Check will be given TIME SLOTS for the Technical Scrutineering. They will be given on the "first comes, first served" principle at the Administrative Check.
- 4 separate lines will be arranged at the Technical Scrutineering: Enduro, ATV/QUAD; Side-by-Side/SSV; CAR and TRUCK.
- Make sure to come on time for your slot.
- All the required equipment as per the technical regulations (for example: helmets, fire extinguishers, seat belt cutters, gloves, tow straps, etc.) have to be prepared in advance before entering the Scrutineering zone on the co-driver's seat when applicable.
- In order to follow the COVID PROTOCOL and large groups of people to be avoided at the Scrutineering –only 1 person shall come with the vehicle.
- Please note the rally vehicle has to be compliant with the requirements in the Technical Regulations during the whole rally. Regular checks during the rally can be done at any time.
- Vehicles from the Discovery category shall not come to the Technical Scrutineering. They need
 to do self-check according the checklist. Equipment and GPS tracker will be checked at the first
 start.
- For better preparation and to save time during the Scrutineering read/download the Scrutineering check list for your racing class, prepare the mandatory equipment and the vehicle:

4. Road book delivery

- Vehicles and team members passed successfully Administrative and Technical check and have received Start Permission, will be given at the end of the Scrutineering zone the road book for Leg 1.
- Reminder: Having received the road book, the crews are NOT ALLOWED to do any form of RECONAISSANCE or TESTING.
- We are in an ACTIVE MILITARY ZONE. Driving outside the allowed times is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.
