RACER REGISTRATION DEADLINES – Friday, Aug. 21 thru Friday Sept. 4

5pm Aug 21 DEADLINE TO REGISTER AND SIGN ONLINE WAIVERS TO HAVE WRISTBANDS MAILED TO YOU. - If you choose to have bands mailed to you, or picked up by someone else, all entry and membership fees must be paid in full. ***After this date and time wristbands will only be issued at on-site registration.***

TO REQUEST BANDS TO BE SENT DIRECT TO YOU, Refer to instructions for “**HOW TO ELECTRONICALLY SIGN WAIVERS**” on our SCORE Website > Race Info > Select Baja 400 logo > Select Waivers.

RECOMMENDATION – At the time you complete your race entry or co-driver/co-rider/navigator registration, go immediately to the digital online waivers and electronically sign the document.

9pm Aug 28 DEADLINE TO REGISTER ONLINE or in person in the ENSENADA OFFICE, to be on the ENTRY LIST, or to Qualify if registering on-line (select classes). All fees must be paid in full.

Qualifying classes will be Trophy Truck, TT 2WD, TT Legends, TT Spec, Class 1 and Pro Ultimate UTV. Qualifying start order will be within class based on date and time the Baja 400 entry is received and fees paid in full. Start position for non-qualifying classes will be by random draw.

CO-DRIVERS, CO-RIDERS, NAVIGATORS REGISTRATION, must have purchased membership and completed an online registration and waivers. Complete your registration to be listed on the ENTRY LIST, SCORE JOURNAL including RACE PROGRAM.

This Race Entry List is used by the Mexico border crossing officials for entry into their country. If you are not on the list, you run the risk of being turned away at the border.

Signing of on-line waivers is **MANDATORY** for all race participants and race vehicle owners. **NOTE:** Beginning with the 2026 San Felipe 250, the on-line waivers only need to be **signed annually** for each vehicle you will be competing in.

AIRCRAFT and DRONE REGISTRATION DEADLINES

OPENS 9am Mon. July 21 – CLOSES, 5pm Friday August 21

DEADLINE TO REGISTER AIRCRAFT AND DRONES. Registration is required to secure permission to participate at the Baja 400. Only those registered and meeting current Mexico requirements will be invited to the MANDATORY Pilot/Drone meeting. For questions, email aircraft@score-international.com.

6pm Race Information (including pre-run stipulations) and GPS files will be available on SCORE website at approximately 6:00 pm at score-international.com > Race Info > Baja 400 logo

SATURDAY, August 29

8am Pre-Running Opens for Baja 400 - NOTE: - You must be registered and team fees paid 100% to be covered by the SCORE insurance during pre-running. Obey all traffic laws, close gates, maintain pre-running speeds, **NOT RACE SPEEDS**, follow the GPS, stay on course and obey all stipulations posted with GPS files. Watch out for moto/quads.

SATURDAY, August 29 - MONDAY, August 31

9am Aug 29- Aug 31 ALL RACERS - Review Entry List contents on website to ensure all registered participants are listed, all sponsors are complete and correct, and all spelling is correct. Any updates or corrections must be **emailed immediately** to Registration@score-international.com. No changes after this Monday Aug. 31 deadline will appear in the SCORE Journal.

FRIDAY, Sept. 4

5pm **DEADLINE TO REGISTER IN PERSON AT THE ENSENADA OFFICE** – Late fees will apply after this date and you will NOT appear on the ENTRY LIST, in the SCORE JOURNAL RACE PROGRAM, or in the START POSITION draw. After close of Ensenada office, all registrations must be done in person at SCORE onsite registration in Ensenada. If registering in Ensenada for a qualifying class, all fees, memberships, and waivers must be completed by this date.

IMPORTANT NOTE – *All SCORE events during this Baja 400 in Ensenada will take place either inside or in front of the Riviera de Ensenada Center (RdEC) on Lazaro Cardenas unless otherwise noted.*

IMPORTANT► *If your Driver of Record takes advantage of onsite Registration on Thursday, you may take race vehicle directly to the Tech/Contingency line. No waiting for your registration to be completed! DO NOT get in tech line until registration is complete.*
